



Splendour China 13 Days visiting **Beijing, Xian, Shanghai, Suzhou, Hangzhou, Wuzhen** (Tour Code: CBL-BBXSSH)

Day 1 (Fri) Vancouver- Beijing.

Day 2 (Sat) Arrive Beijing.

Meet & transfer to the hotel upon arrival.

CHANG AN GRAND HOTEL BEIJING or similar (superior class)

Day 3 (Sun) Beijing (B. L. D)

This morning we start tours to Tiananmen Square and the extravagant and the largest Imperial Palace in the world -the Forbidden City, then we approach to the largest imperial garden in the world, the elegant Summer Palace including cruise on the shimmering waters of Kunming Lake. After that we visit the Panda's Garden in Beijing Zoo.

Day 4 (Mon) Beijing (B. L. D)

Visit "Beijing 2008 Olympic Center" -the Bird's Nest & Water Cube –where hosts many spectacular events. We stroll around the outside for photography, and then we continue to the Great Wall Badaling and walk along its ramparts for breathtaking views of the largest man power project in history. After that we approach to the mountain valley of the best geomancy site -the Ming Dynasty's Imperial Tomb including visit the Sacred Stature Road. Peking Opera or Cultural shows later.

Day 5 (Tue) Beijing (B. L. SD)

This morning we visit the Temple of Heaven, including visit to the Imperial Hall of Pray Harvest, the Imperial Vault and the Imperial Sacrificial Altar. We may see local people doing Taiji and morning exercises there. Then we visit Beijing City Planning Museum and watch a 3D film which tells the glory history and fast changes of Beijing. Afternoon we take the old-fashioned Peci cab to the historical sites behind main streets by Hutong Tour. We visit Pearl Workshop if time permits. Tonight we enjoy Peking Duck Dinner

Day 6 (Wed) Beijing/Xian by air (B. L. D)

Fly to Xian, Transfer to AURUM INTERNATIONAL or similar.

Visit the landmark of Xian-Big Wild Goose Pagoda & the famous Provincial Museum.

Day 7 (Thu) Xian (B. L. SD)

Full day excursion tour to the site of Qin Terra-cotta Warriors & Bronze Chariots, We will watch the archaeologists continuing on the fields for further excavation. Afternoon on the route back to the city we visit the Ceramics & Pottery Center.

Tonight Dumpling Dinner & Tang Dynasty Show.

Day 8 (Fri) Xian/Shanghai by air (B, L)

Fly to Shanghai. Transfer to hotel. Afternoon free at leisure.

Day 9 (Sat) Shanghai**(B. L. D)**

Visit Shanghai Old Town and classical Yu Garden. Old Downtown has many narrow zigzag lanes, small squares, fish ponds and pavilions and it collects many favorite local bars, restaurants, tea houses and souvenir shops. Yu Garden was built 400 years ago, it is a famous ancient private garden with architectures of Ming and Qing dynasties. Afternoon we visit Shanghai Museum, including enormous finest stone sculptures, bronze-wares, porcelain, calligraphic works, Chinese paintings and ancient furniture. After the Museum we stroll to the People's Square. The surroundings are the best collections of modern architecture. If time's available we visit the Carpet Factory. Tonight we enjoy the famous Shanghai Acrobatic Show.

Day 10 (Sun) Shanghai / Suzhou by bus**(B. L. D)**

Suzhou is renowned as Oriental Venice for its exquisite canals, artificial architectures and elegant gardens. Visit the Master of Nets Garden and Humble Administrator's Garden and enjoying a cruise along the canal from the city to a picturesque Hanshan Temple.

Day 11 (Sun) Shanghai / Hangzhou by bus**(B. L. D)**

Travel to Hangzhou, the city which is regarded as the "Paradise on Earth", we will take Sampan Cruise on the picturesque West Lake, Six Harmonies Pagoda or Yanggong Dyke & Guzhuang Garden, and then the region's most famous tea village in the green valley

Day 12 (Tue) Hangzhou / Wuzhen / Shanghai by bus**(B. L. D)**

Return to Shanghai and en route, visit Wuzhen, one of the best preserved water towns in China. We'll visit the traditional houses, a rice wine brewery and a weaving workshop and dye house, a street corner opera stage, where you can enjoy a puppet show. Then we continue our way to Shanghai.
